INFORMATION

WHAT IS IN YOUR PACKET

Please make sure to have the all of the following items before leaving the expo. Please make sure that all items are worn on the appropriate places before arriving to the Transition Area.

1. Athlete Wristband: For security purposes this must be worn at all times on race day. It designates that you are a registered entrant in the race. No wristband, no transition area access, no race, NO EXCEPTIONS. Make sure to keep your wristband on after you have completed the race as it will be needed in order to remove your bike from the transition area. If you are in a relay, please make sure you have the biker wear the numbered wristband, and the swimmer & runner wear the blank wristbands.
2. Race Bib #: Race bib should be worn during the biking and running portions of the triathlon. It must be front facing when crossing the finish line of race. You will receive safety pins to secure the bib but a race belt is highly recommended.
3. Timing Chip: Inside the packet you will find a timing chip. Follow all instructions! IT MUST BE WORN ON ANKLE and RETURNED AT FINISH!
4. Bike #: Position this number on the bike by peeling off the backing and stick on the top bar or on the seat tube.
5. Bike Helmet #: Peel off backing so the number is sticky. Position number on the front center of the helmet and press to stick.

ADDITIONAL ITEMS TO PICK-UP

1. Swim Cap: You must pick up the required swim cap at the expo. This cap designates your wave and must be worn during the race swim. Double check that the swim cap matches the correct wave you are assigned to. Make sure you leave in the appropriate wave to avoid disqualification.

TRANSITION AREA

The Transition Area is located on Back Bay Drive near Jamboree, just outside the Newport Dunes Waterfront Resort. Bike racks are assigned according to waves. The racks are first come first served, by wave.

- Transition area opens at 5:30a and closes at 7:00a. No participants will be allowed to drop off their bike prior to race morning. Use the non-timed entrances to get into the transition area. VIP registered athletes will have designated racks in the transition area.
- Body marking will be completed outside the transition area before the start of the race.
- Toilets will be located outside the transition area next to Pavilion C & D (Finish Festival).

WAVE START TIMES

It is required that you start in the wave to which you have been assigned. Failure to comply will result in the damaging of another competitor's results and awards. Please make sure your cap color matches your assigned wave.

RELAYS

Swimmer – Wear the timing chip, swim cap, and wristband.

Cyclist – Wait at the bike rack for your swimmer. Swimmer hands off the timing chip at the rack. Wear the Bike #, Helmet #, and wristband.

Runner – Wait at the bike rack for your cyclist. Cyclist hands off the timing chip at the rack. Please wear the race bib and wristband.

AID STATIONS

Following is a list of aid stations that all include Gatorade and Arrowhead Water.

1. Transition Entrance and Exit
2. Back Bay View Park (CLIF Product)
3. Finish Line and Post Race Food

These protected habitats are very delicate and easily damaged when disturbed. Please stay on the paved Back Bay Drive during the race portion and do not enter any other areas of the Reserve.
